## What's Room Ten Learning?

October is a fantastic month to be in Room Ten. In September, we really reviewed a sentence and a basic paragraph. Now we are going to dive even further and learn a Power Ten Paragraph and how to make interesting paragraphs that make sense. We will begin Social Studies and Science this month. Our scholars will begin going to Mrs. Lorenz's class for science. They will be learning about sound and magnets. We will be learning about families, and ways of life in social studies. In math we will begin two-digit addition and subtraction. Keep practicing those math facts. Our Open Court program has our scholars learning and reading stories about sharing stories. They're also learning about comparing, contrasting, pronouns, time and order words, action verbs, making inferences, and possessive nouns.



## What Can Room Ten do at Home?

- This is a great time to take your scholars to the library and have them share stories with their families.
- Please keep practicing addition and subtraction facts.
- Have your child practicing fluency reading at home. Remember that we want them reading 70 words per minute.
- They can always write poetry and stories at home to share with the class.

- Homework should be planned out and done by your child. I would really like you to review and correct the homework with your child the day before it is due. This allows the child one on one time to really show that they understand the homework.
